#### **Responsibility: a buzz word that affects both individuals and government.**

According to The South African Human Rights Commission (SAHRC) (2019), incidence of human rights violation in South Africa (SA) is increasing, despite various attempts to eradicate this tendency. The scariest thing is that the SAHRC bases its interpretation of such incidence on reported cases and those that have been brought to the attention of the institution. Much is happening in our society and most cases are not being reported about making it difficult for a correct account to be given on the extent of this challenge.

To complicate matters, human rights violation assumes different forms and they happen in different contexts. The advent of social media has actually accelerated the problem. Most human rights violation happens under the guises of media freedom and freedom of expression (Babu, 2019).

Lastly, the Department of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries (DEFF) (2022) admits that creating a safe and healthy environment is the responsibility of all citizens of a country. They further argued that, “no legislation is enough to deal with this problem, unless people consider it in their daily lives” (DEFF, 2022). Therefore, individuals in communities could change this situation. All it takes is a conscious decision to be responsible.

Another area that requires human responsibility to deal with is the irresponsible usage of electronic media. Globalization and the advent of the digital age brought to bear increased usage of electronic media. The emphasis has been on usage and little has been said about the responsibility required to use it beneficially and safely. In essence, the dangers of use and abuse of social media has not been an area that most users paid attention to. Their only interests were on usage of the different media platforms without paying much attention to the negative consequences of abuse. Notably, words such as technological/cyber - savvy, cyber-wellness, cyber-safety and cyber-wellness are used loosely.

**CYBER BULLYING IN SOUTH AFRICA**

Recent studies show that nine out of ten (92.9%) of the 12 to 24-year-olds either own or have access to a mobile phone, which they expend for their personal use.

According to a survey conducted in Cape Town, Durban, Bloemfontein and Johannesburg including Pretoria, 81% of learners aged between 13 and 17 years had access to a computer at home, and 62% were able to use their home computers to access the internet.

Therefore, cyber bullying affects many adolescents and teens on daily basis in South Africa. Many South African children are reluctant to report when they are bullied online to the adults or to schools or to other organisations that deal with violation of human rights.
